She is credited with helping to establish and develop public resistance against environmental destruction and the campaign to stop clearcutting, including the use of the earth-spun mole rat—a rodent with a mandible that closes itself tight like a trap when threatened. She was also a leader in developing wilderness and conservation education programs, designing research projects and running the Earth First! Research Center and the Barbel I conference. She served as an advisor to several environmental organizations, including the Sierra Club and the National Parks Association. She was the first speaker at the first Earth First! Conference in Redwood National and State Parks and the Regional Earth First! Direct Action Conference. Early life Barbara F. Childress was born in Cincinnati, Ohio on April 5, 1918, the daughter of Carl Theodore Childress and Florence (Wertheimer) Childress. She married an official of the Bob Marshall Wilderness Areas, Norman Hubbard, in 1941 and they were eventually sent to the wilderness areas on a Forest Service assignment. Career In the early 1960s, Norm and Barbara were introduced to Buddhist practice by the author of The World of Buddhism, Thich Nhat Hanh, while teaching in Montreal, Canada. The couple became converts, moving to San Francisco and then to a farm in Potter Valley, a few miles outside the Plumas National Forest. They started, in 1969, the Earth First! Research Center to share their Buddhist ideals about non-violence in a practice-based research setting. In f988f36e3a
